Age Group	Below 40 years of age
Academic – Degree	Minimum Upper Second Class Bachelor degree with honours & CGPA of 3.3
Scholarship duration	Up to 24 months
Scholarship Amount	Up to RM30,000 per scholar
Studies Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Full-time / part-time master studies (12-24 months programme) 2. Must have gained admission into a recognised local public or private university or college 3. For twinning programmes, the full duration of the programme must be done locally 4. No restriction on field of studies
Other Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No bonding required 2. Combined monthly household income is RM3,000 and below 3. Applicants must not be in receipt of any other scholarship, or award from any educational institutions, or any other organisations / foundation 4. Education loan is permissible if the scholarship amount is not sufficient to cover tuition fees 5. Successful applicants must be able to maintain a CGPA of 3.30 or equivalent throughout the duration of his/her studies
