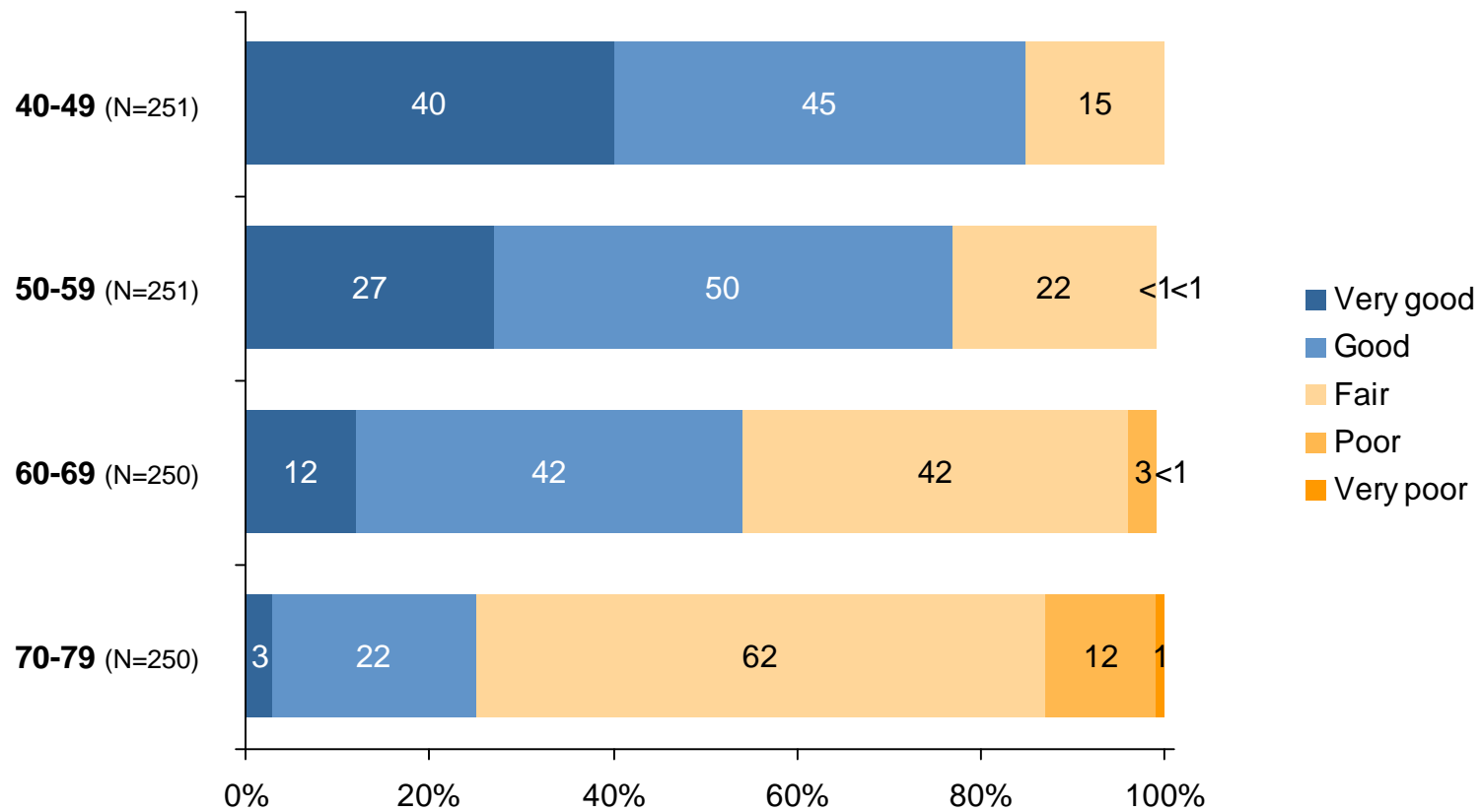

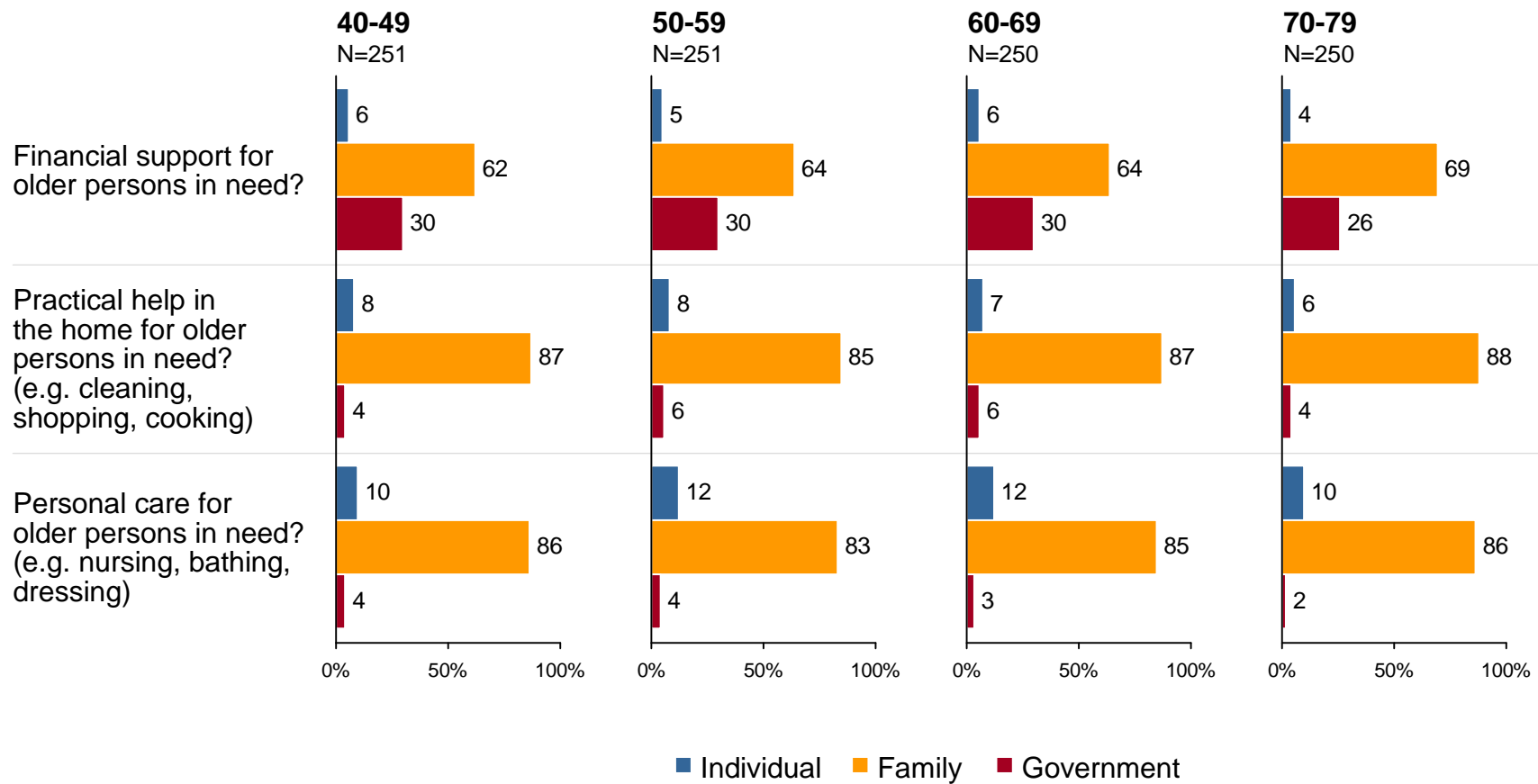

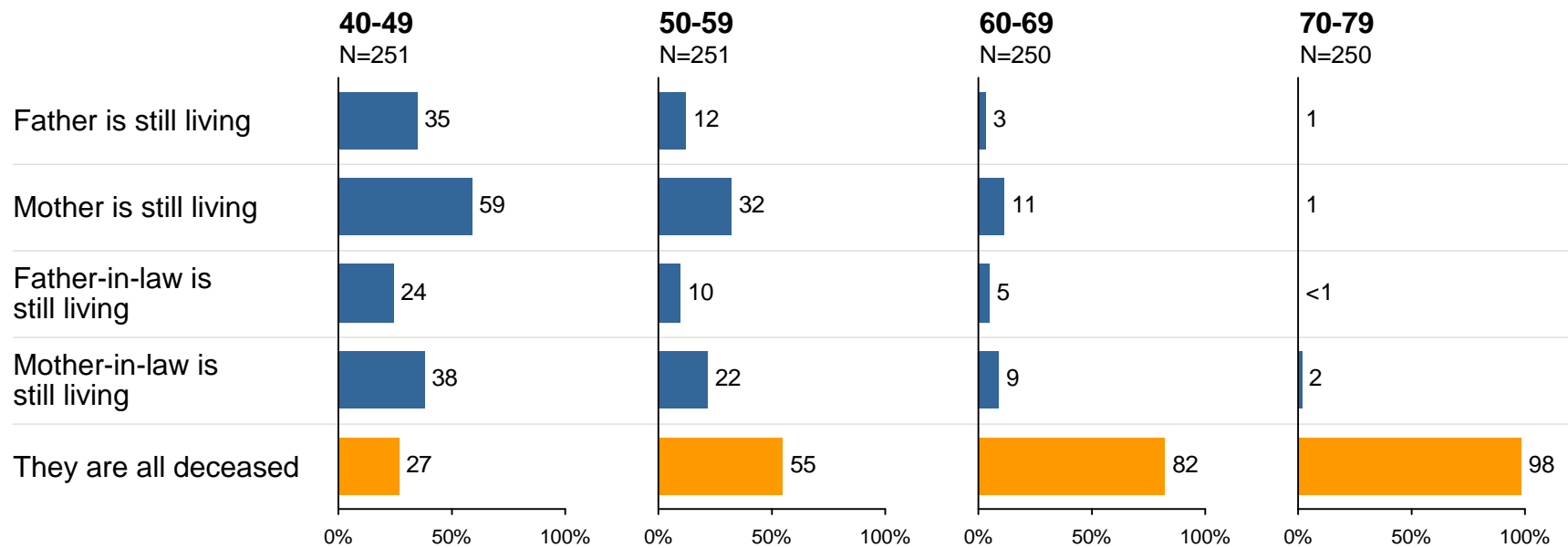

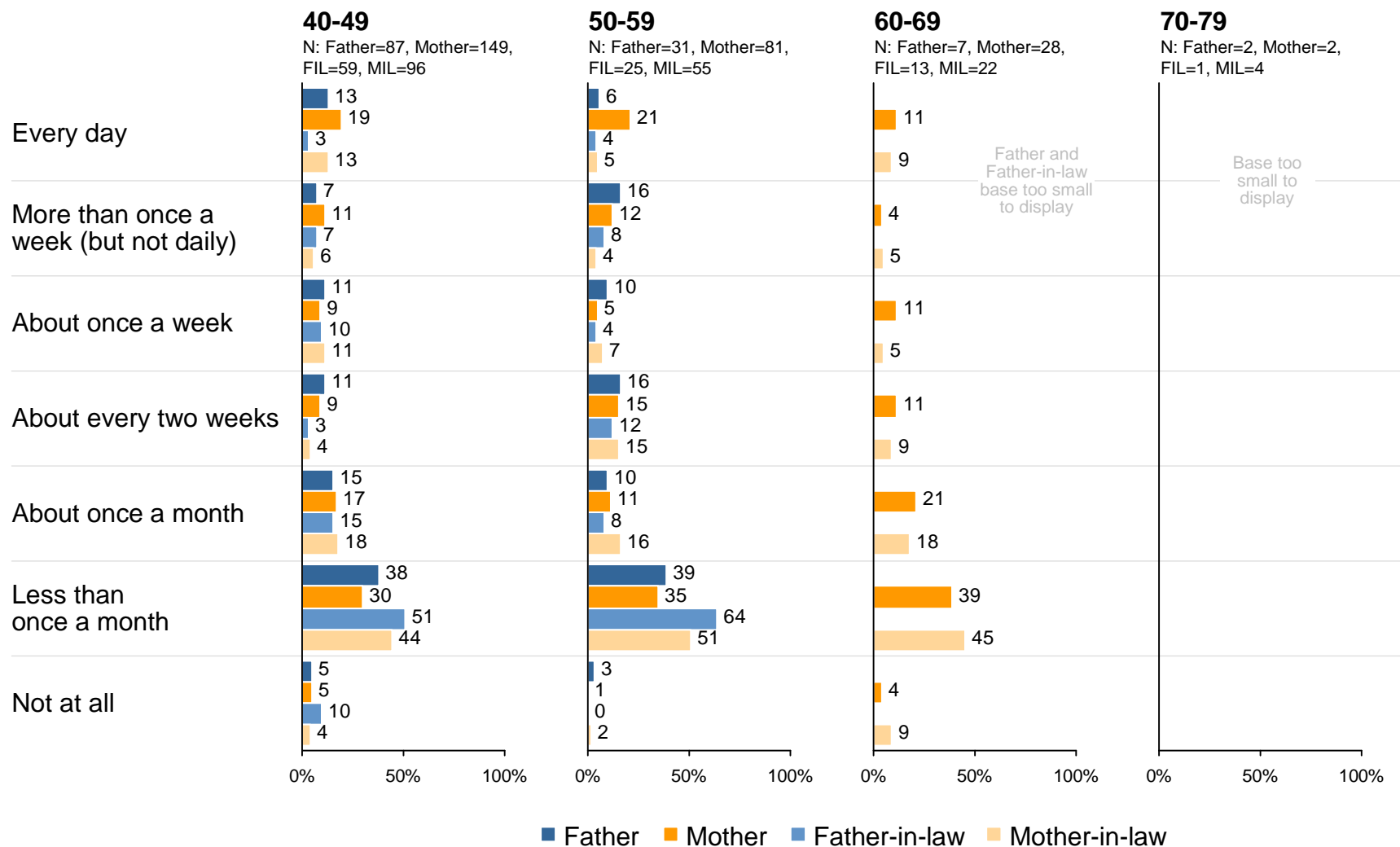
# Where do your parent(s)/parent(s)-in-law live?

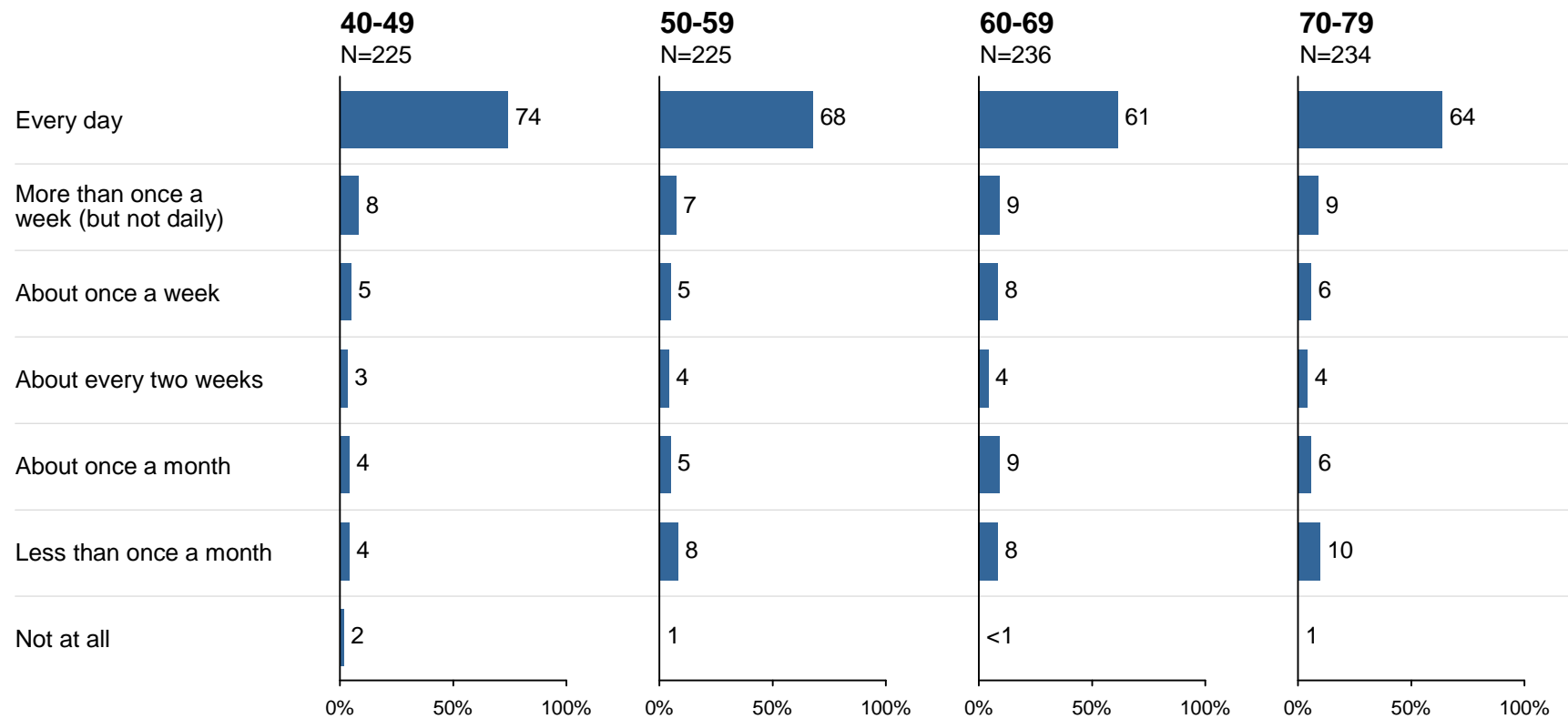

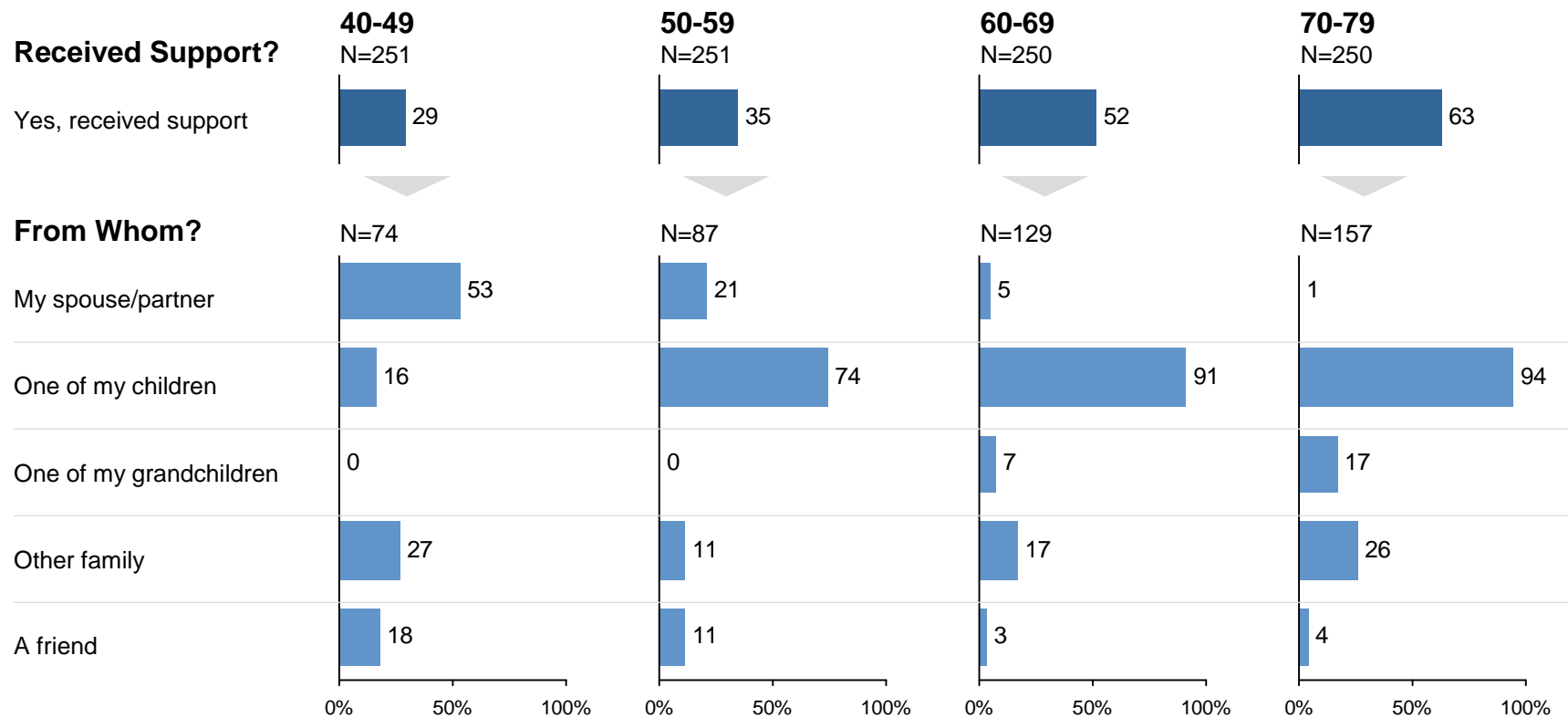

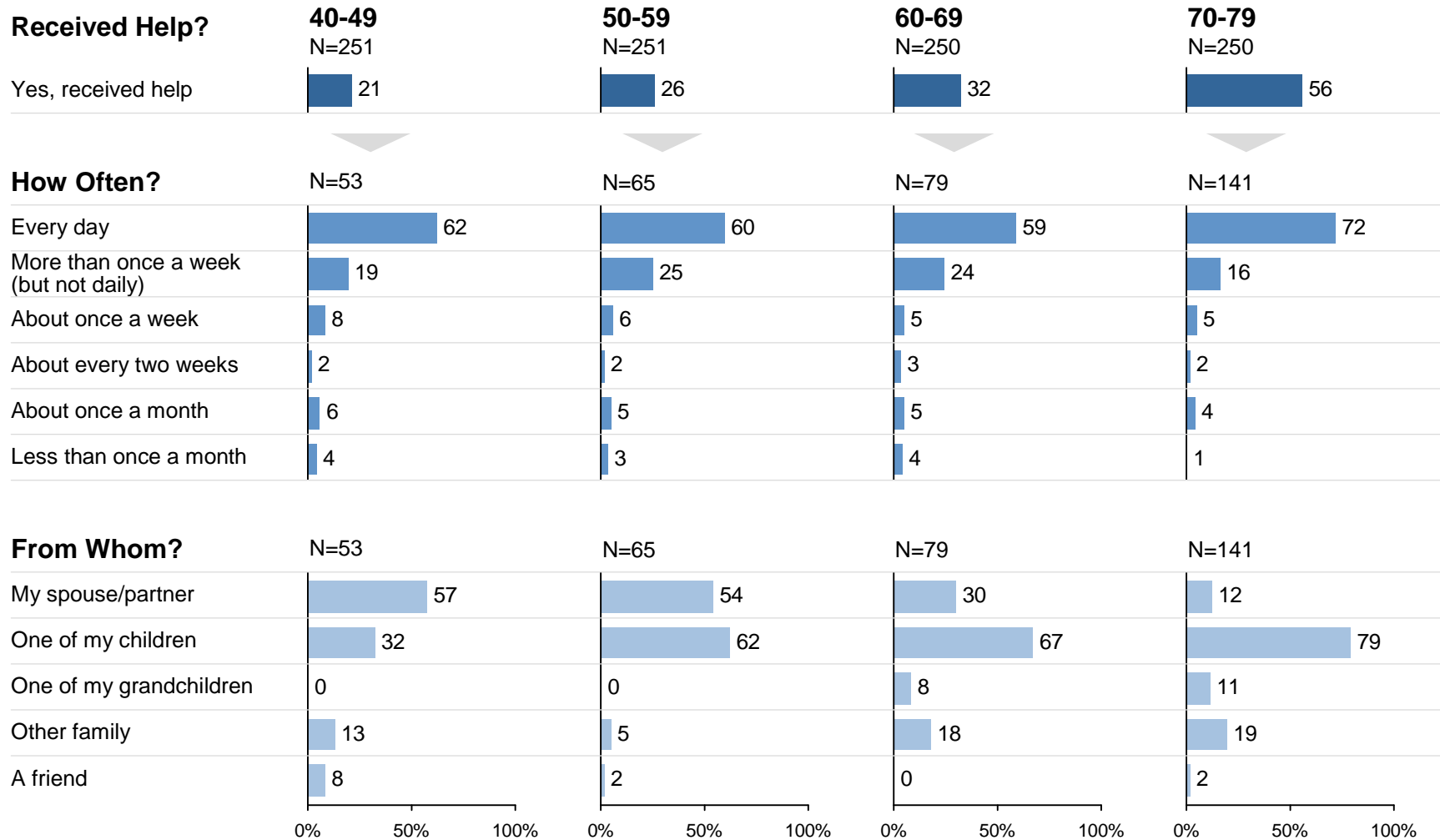

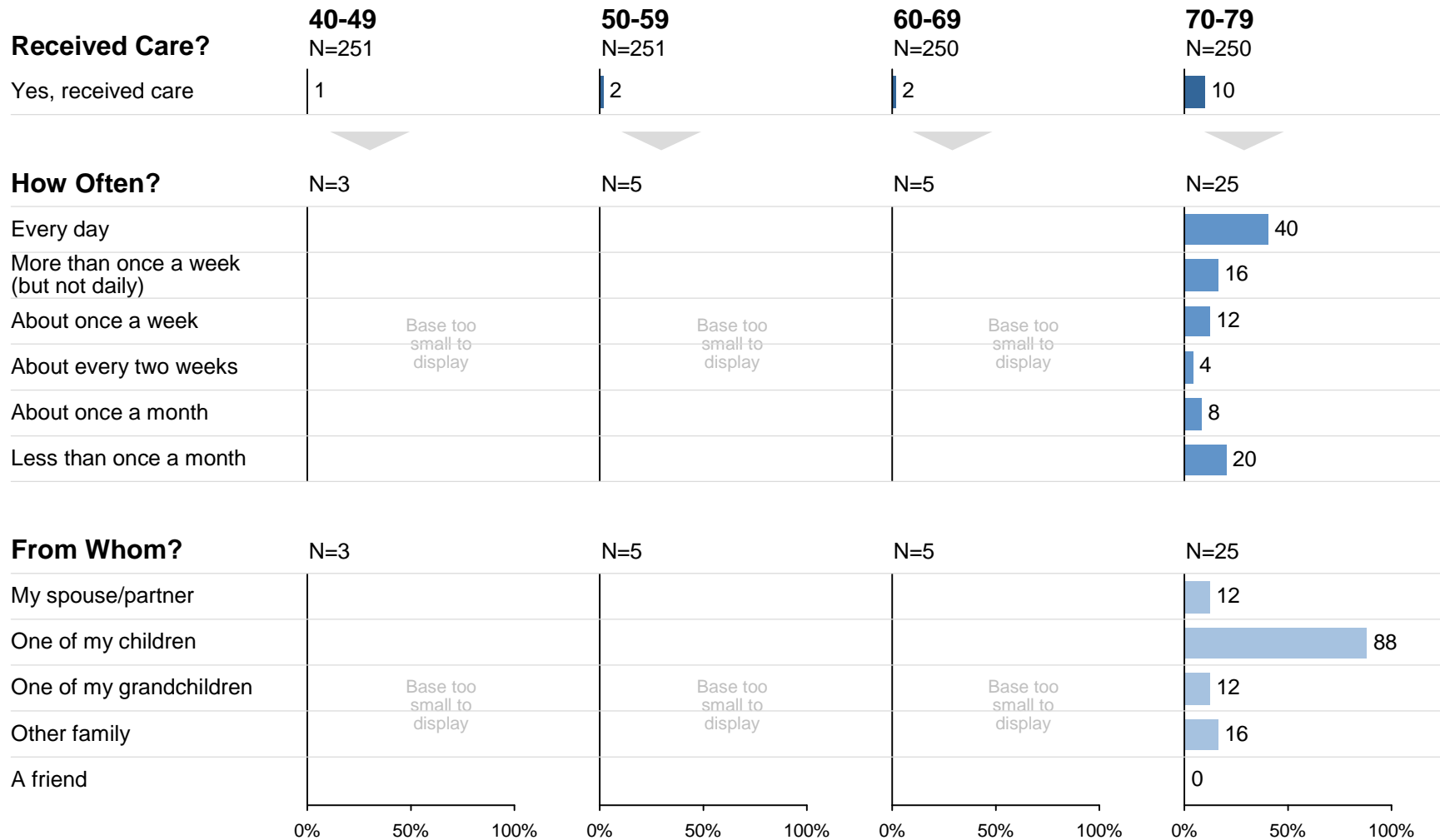

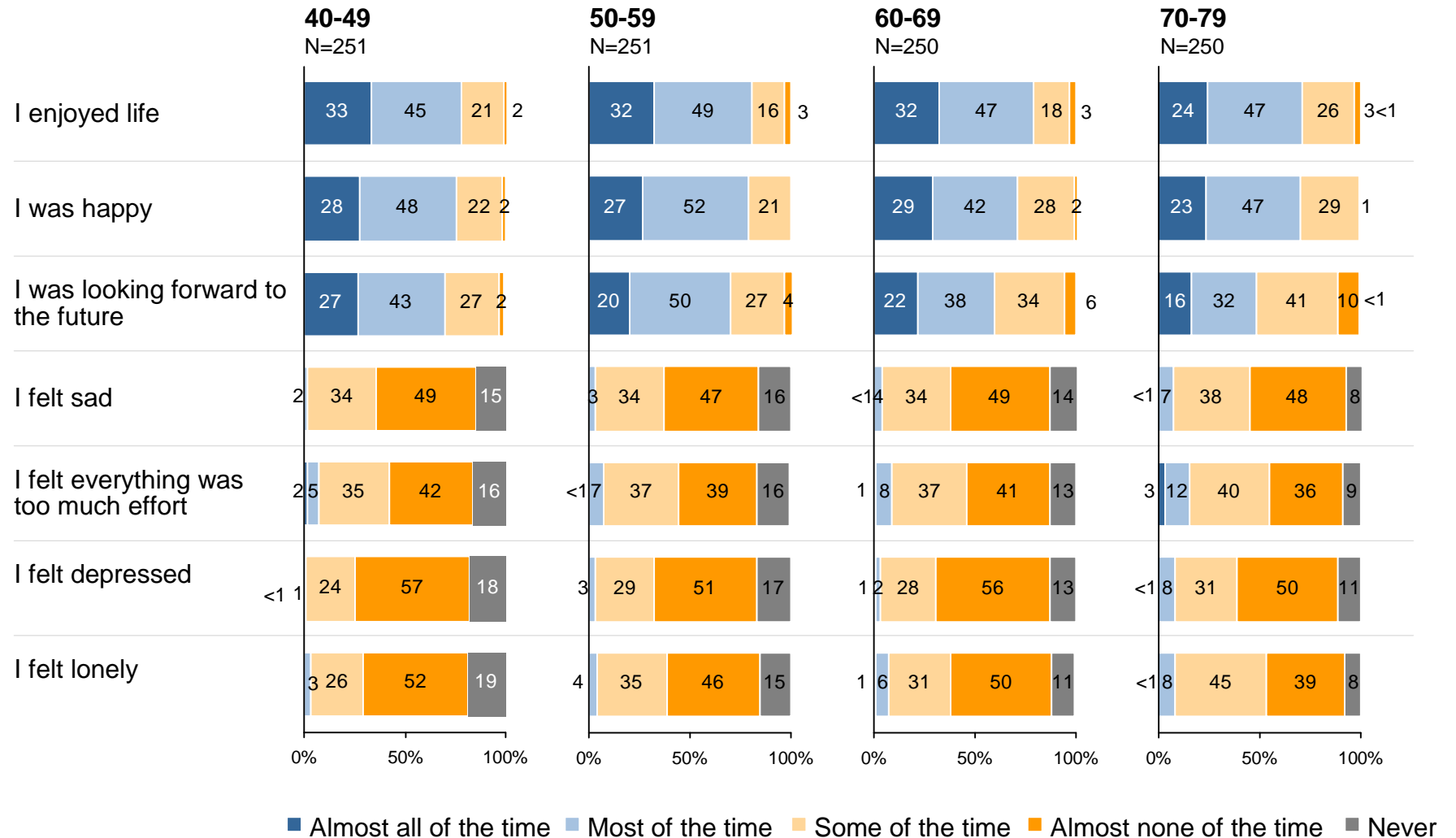

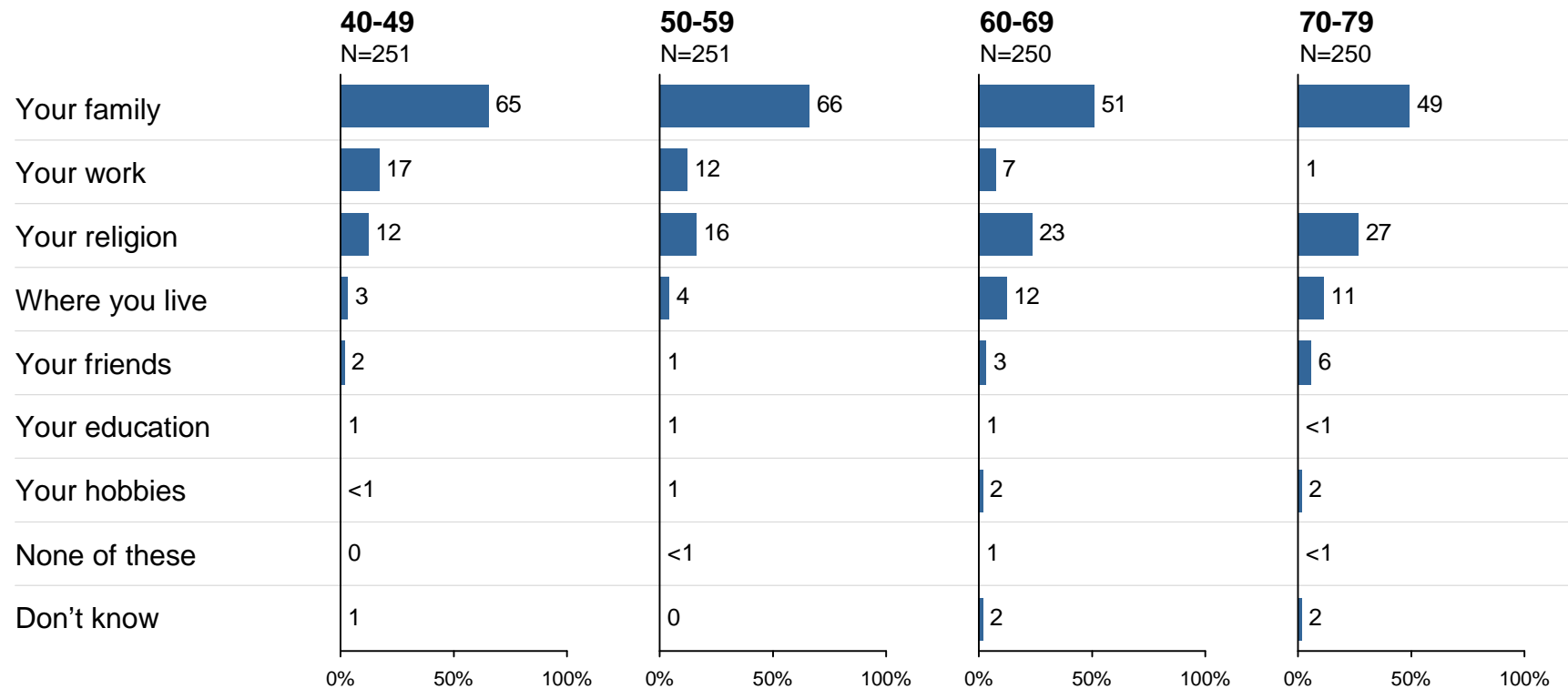

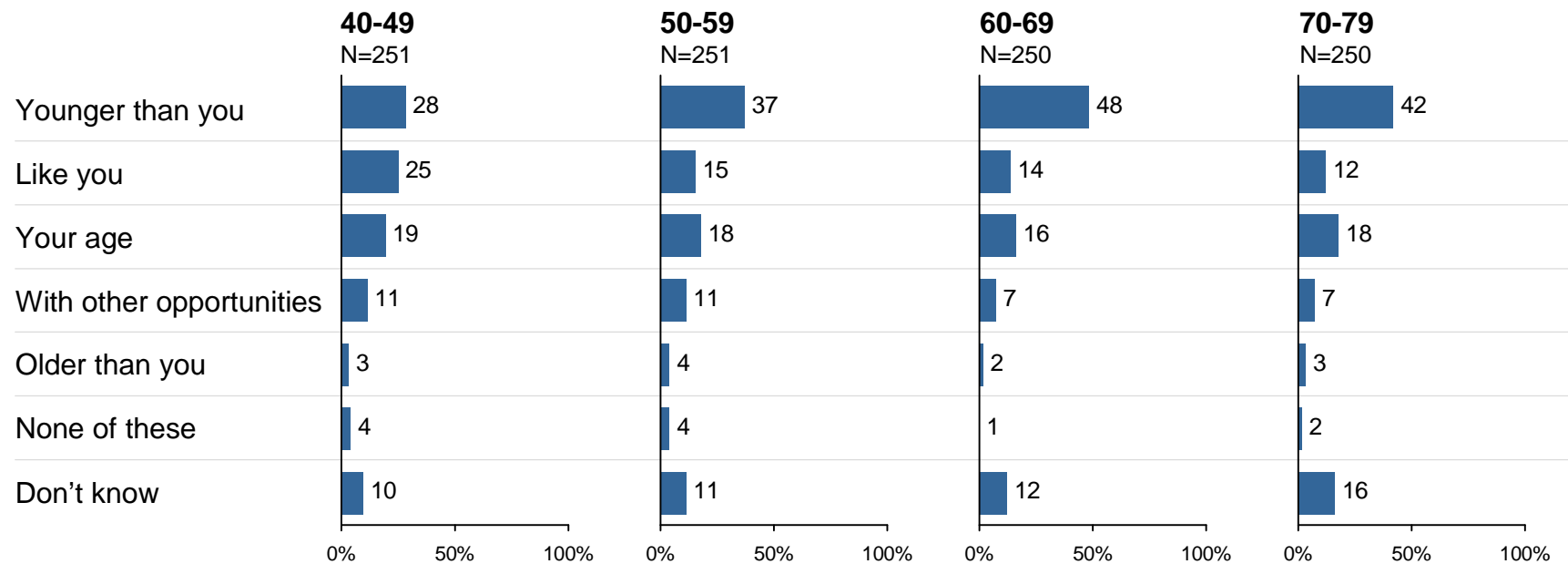

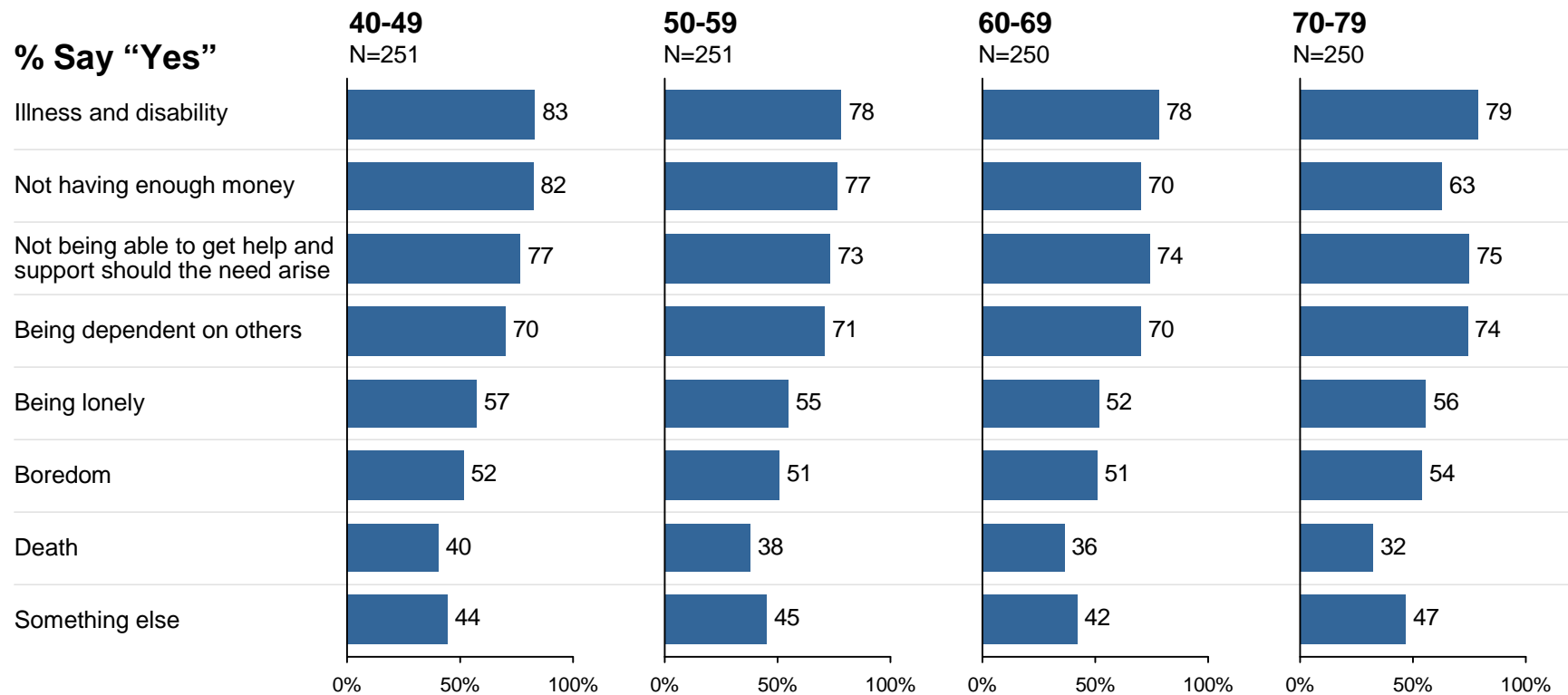

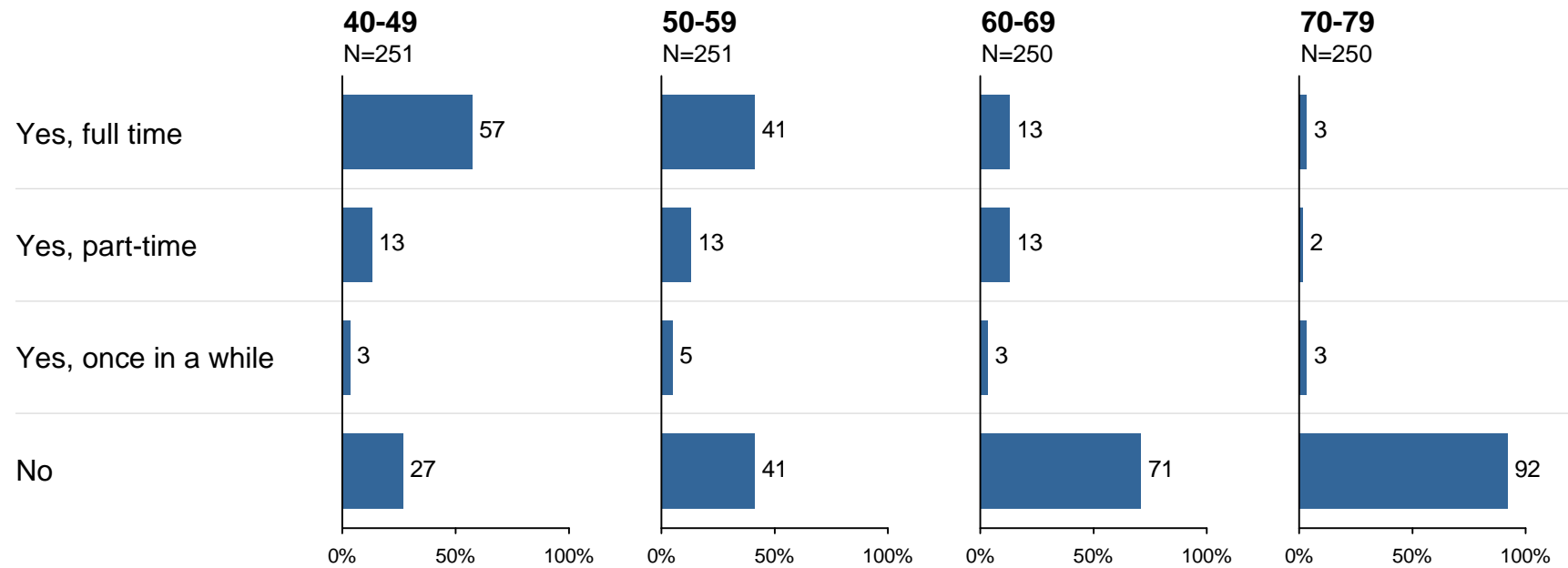

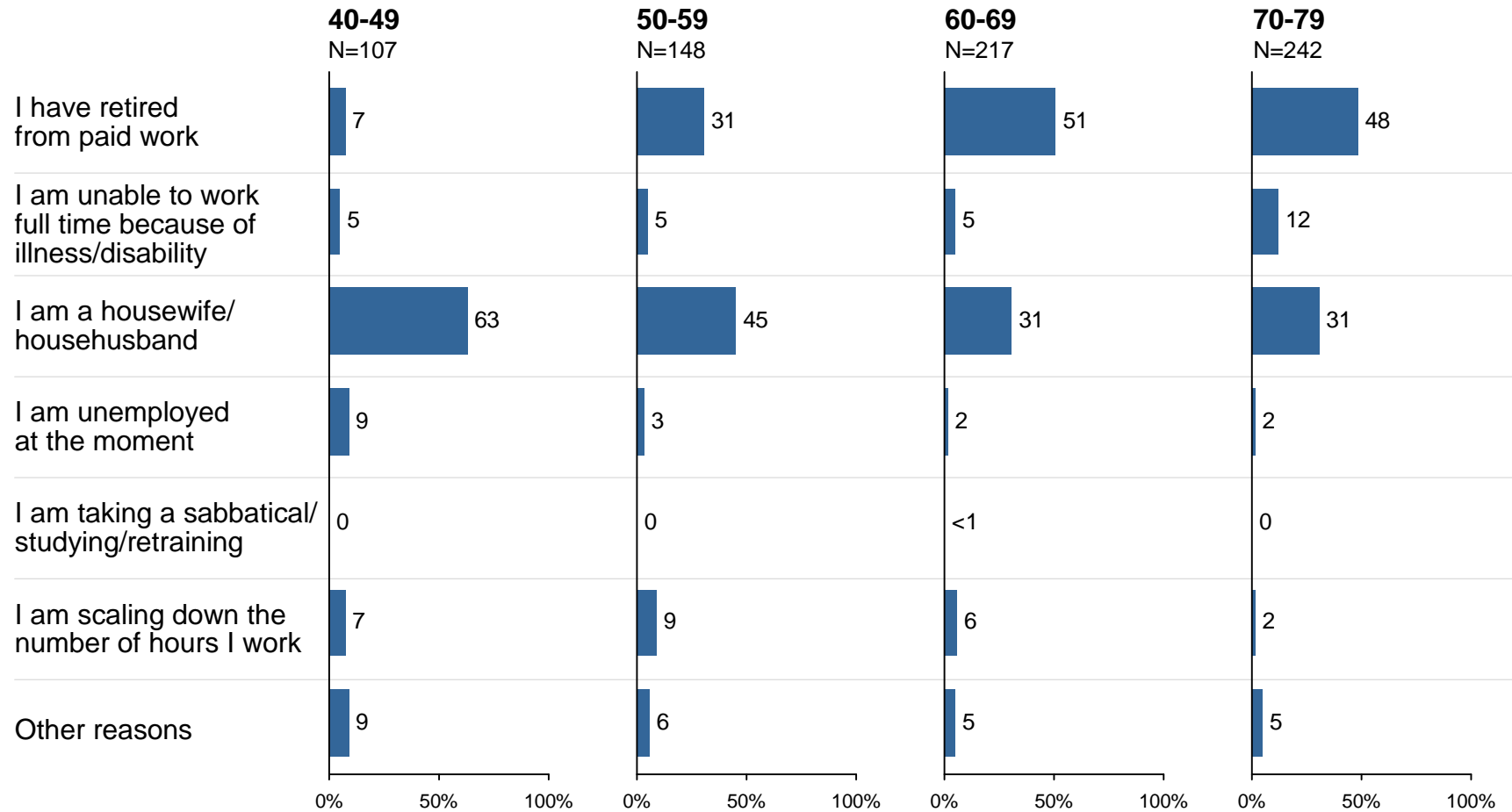

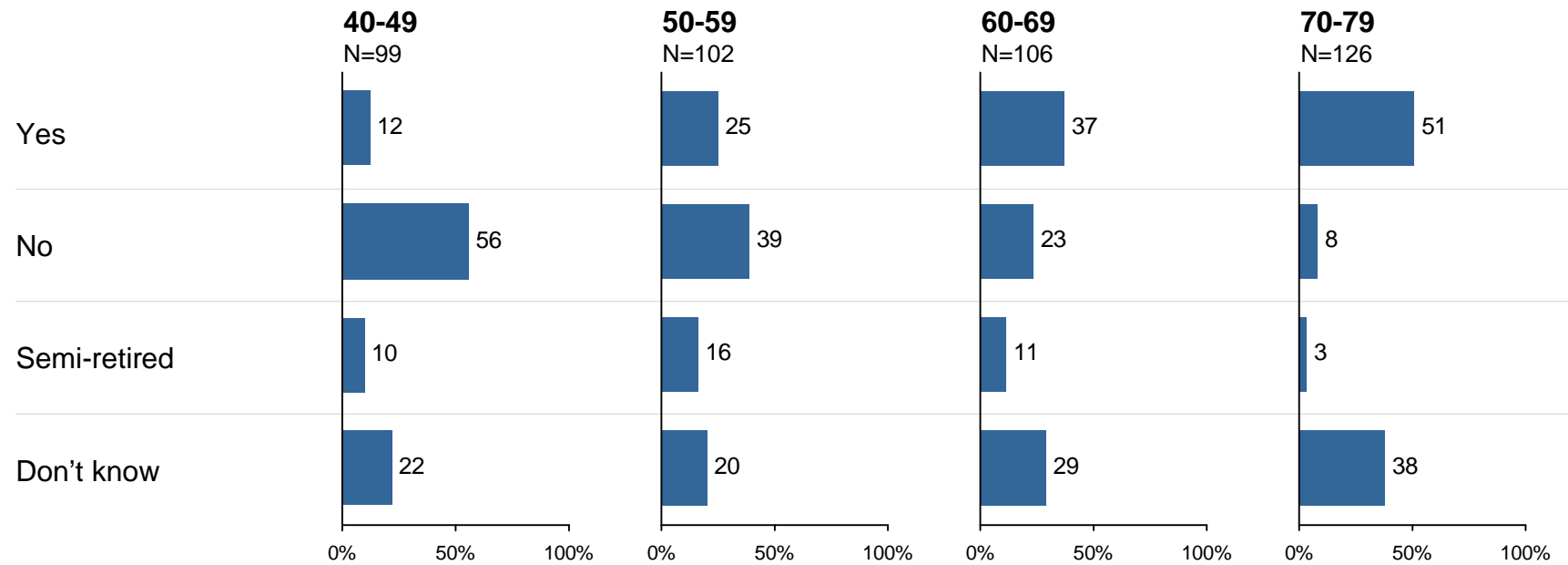

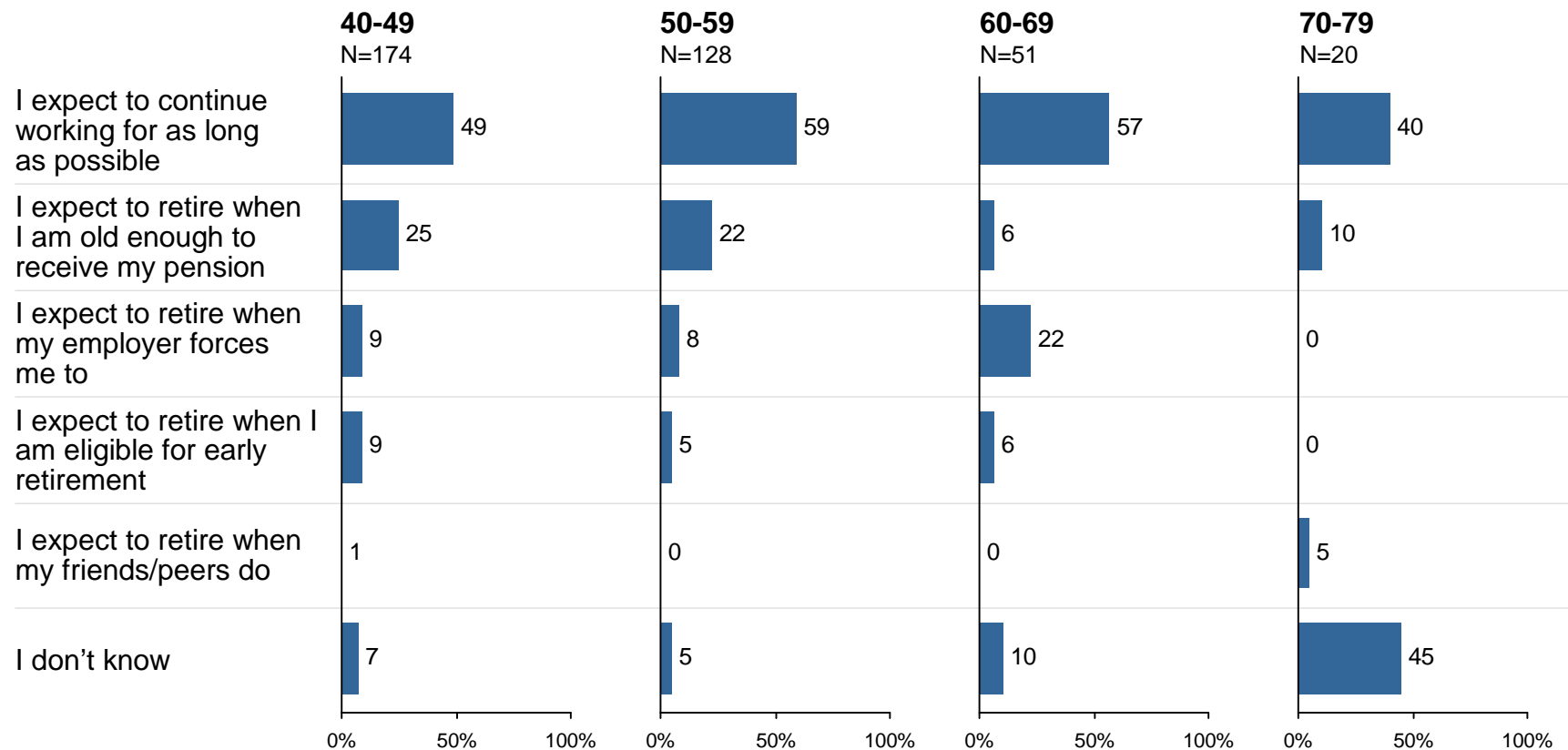

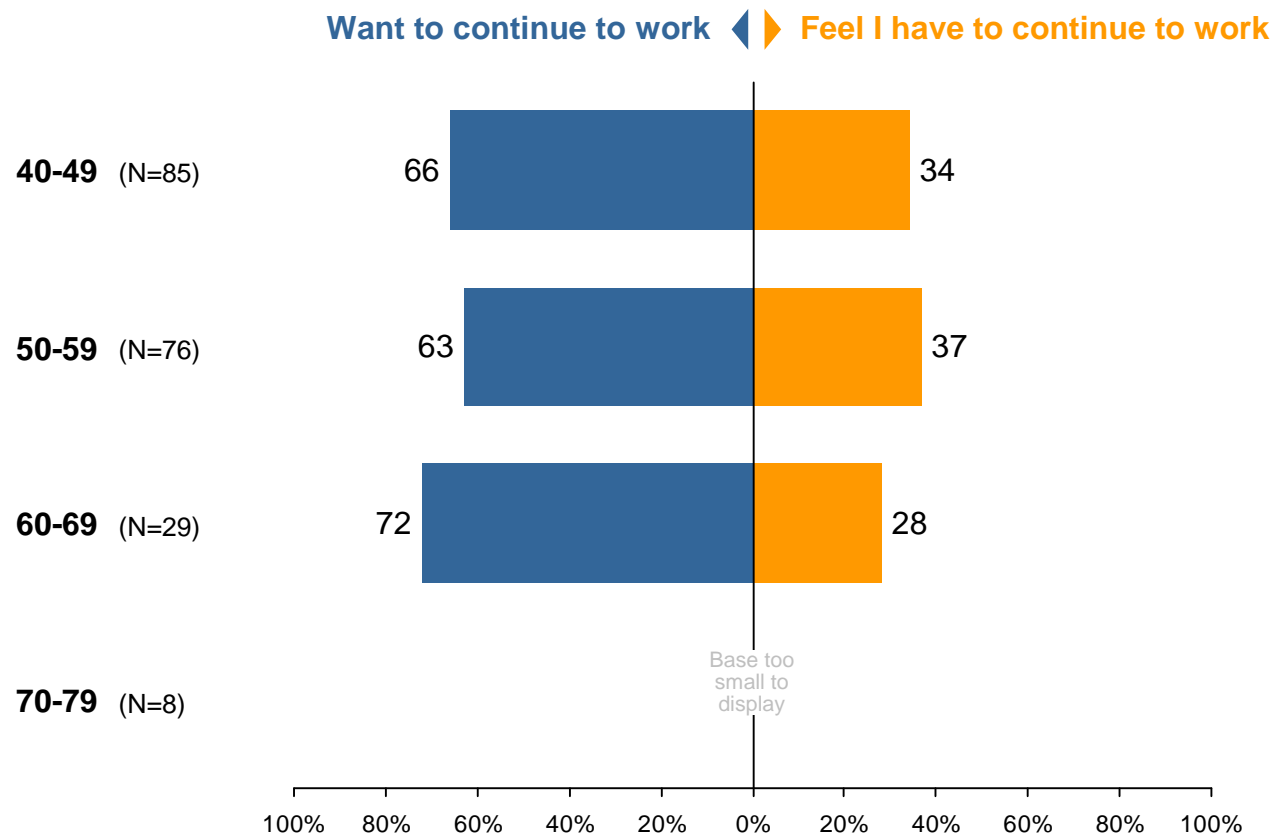

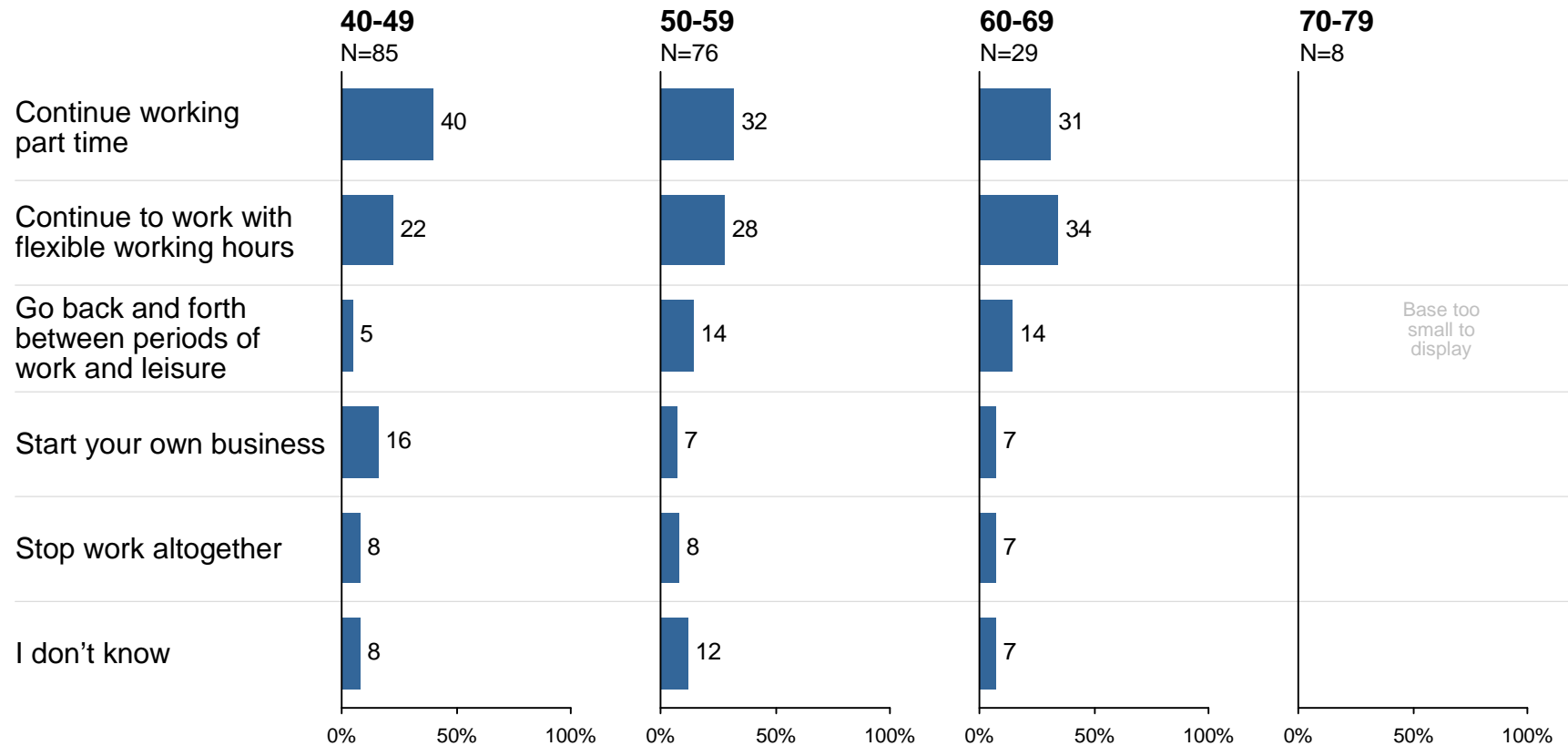

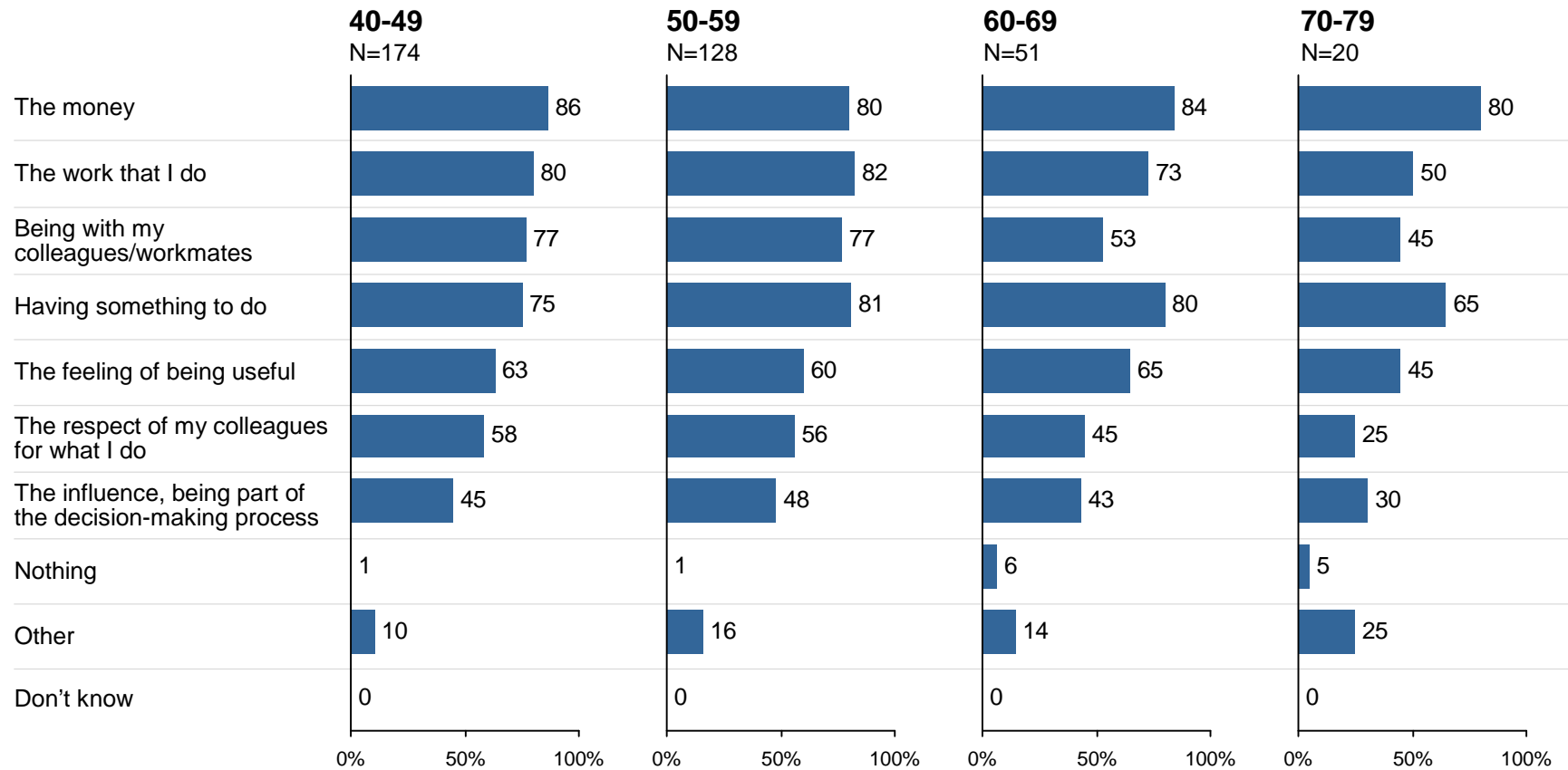
# When you retire from your current occupation, which of the following options would you prefer to do?



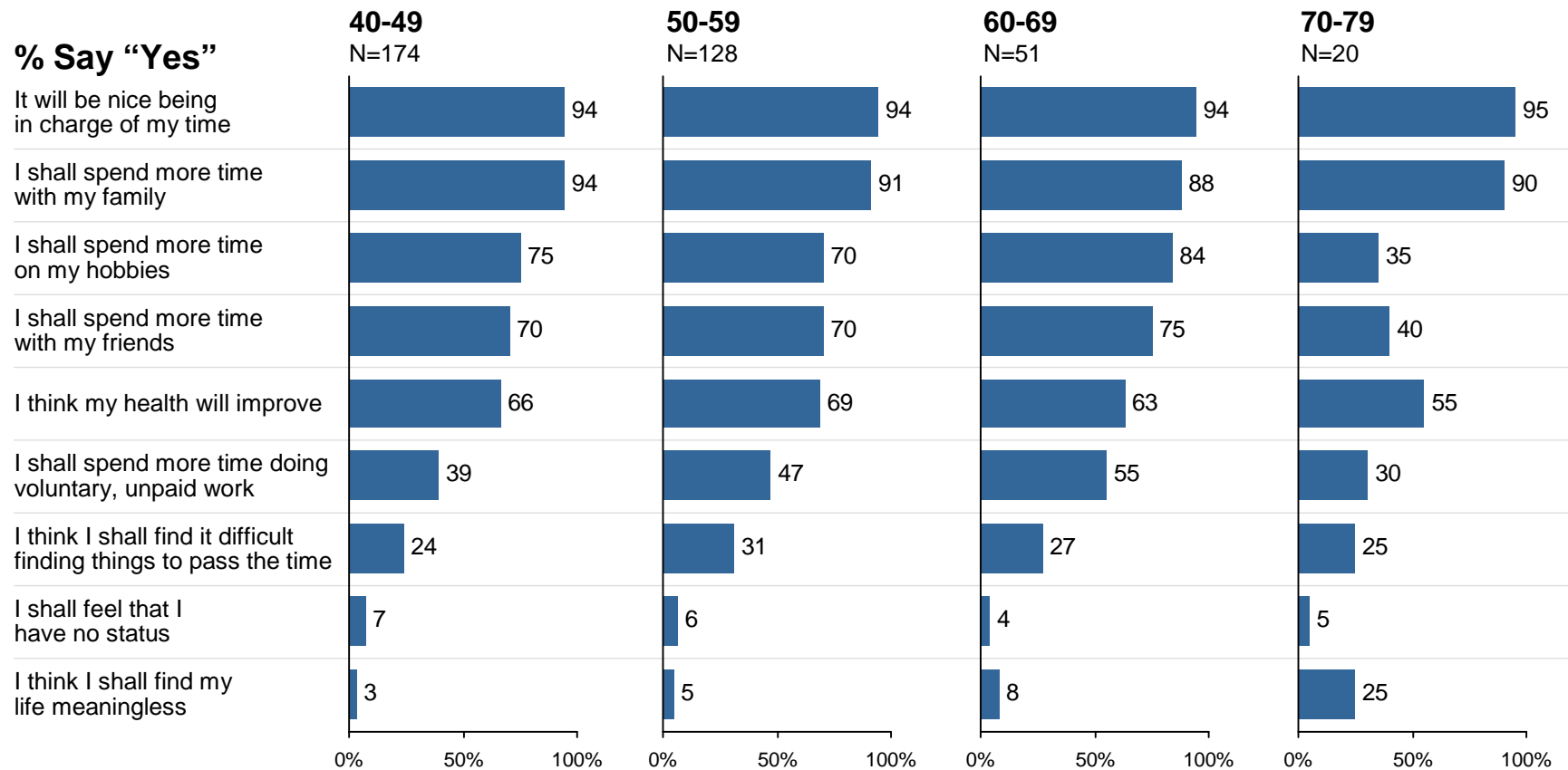

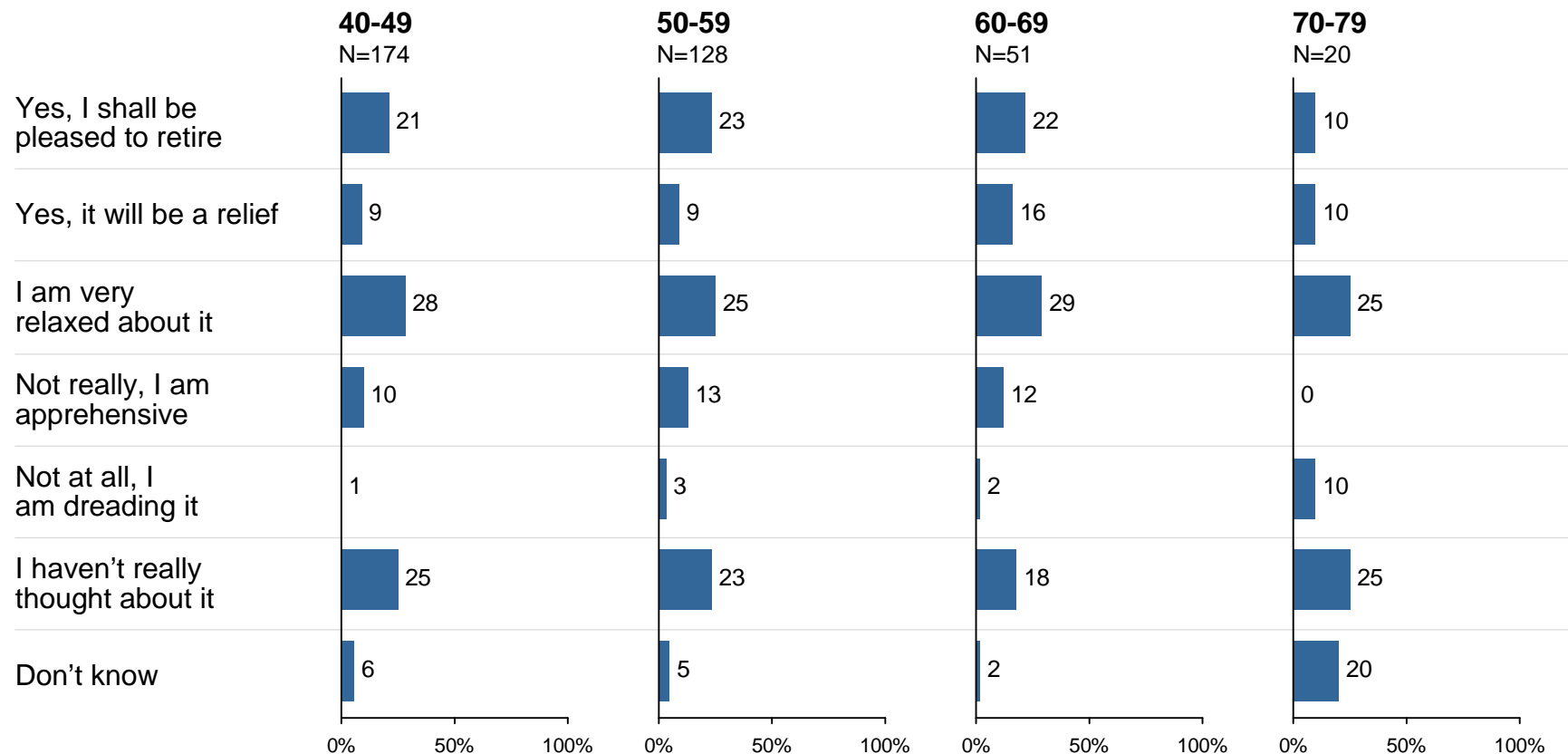

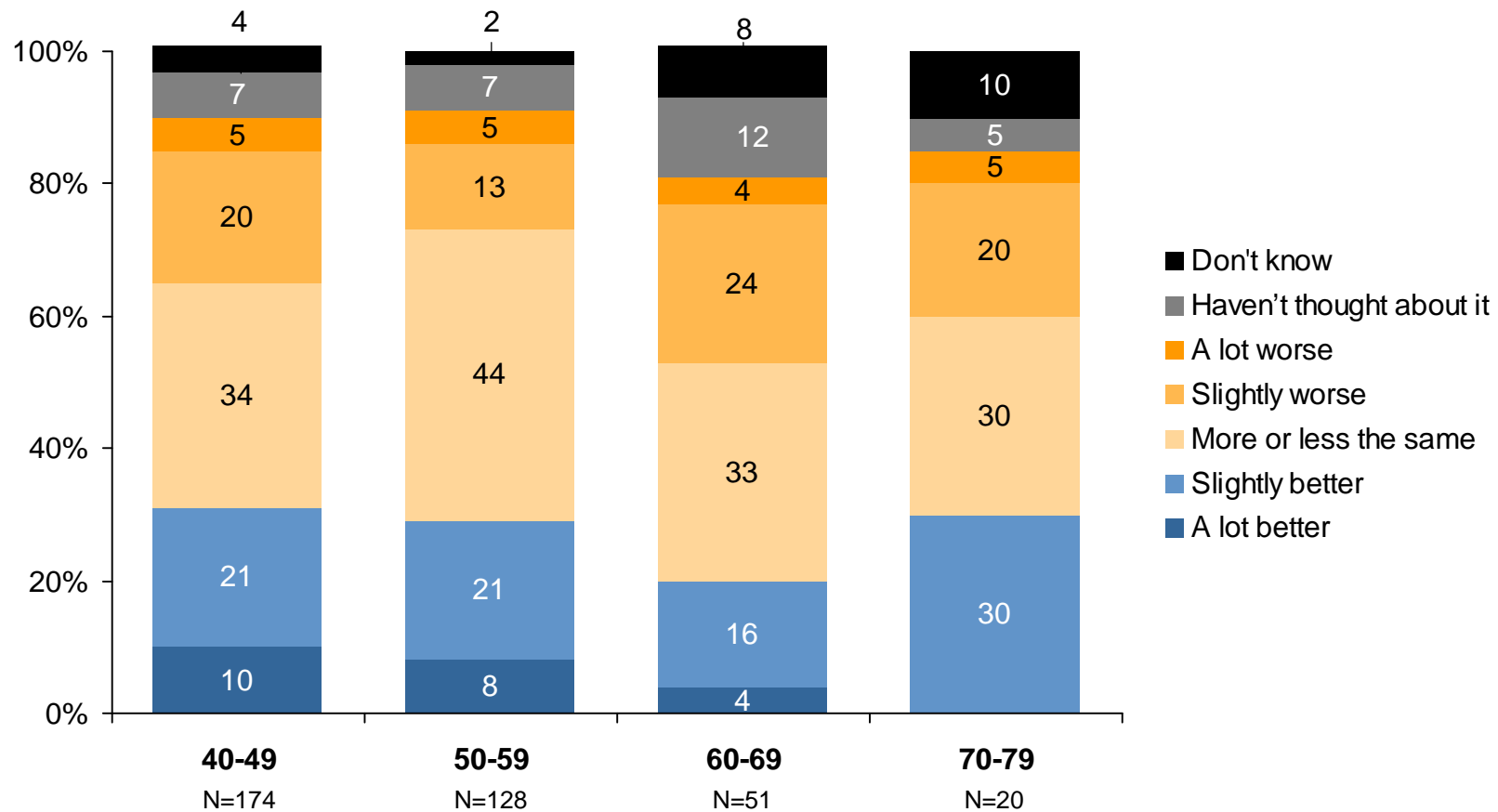

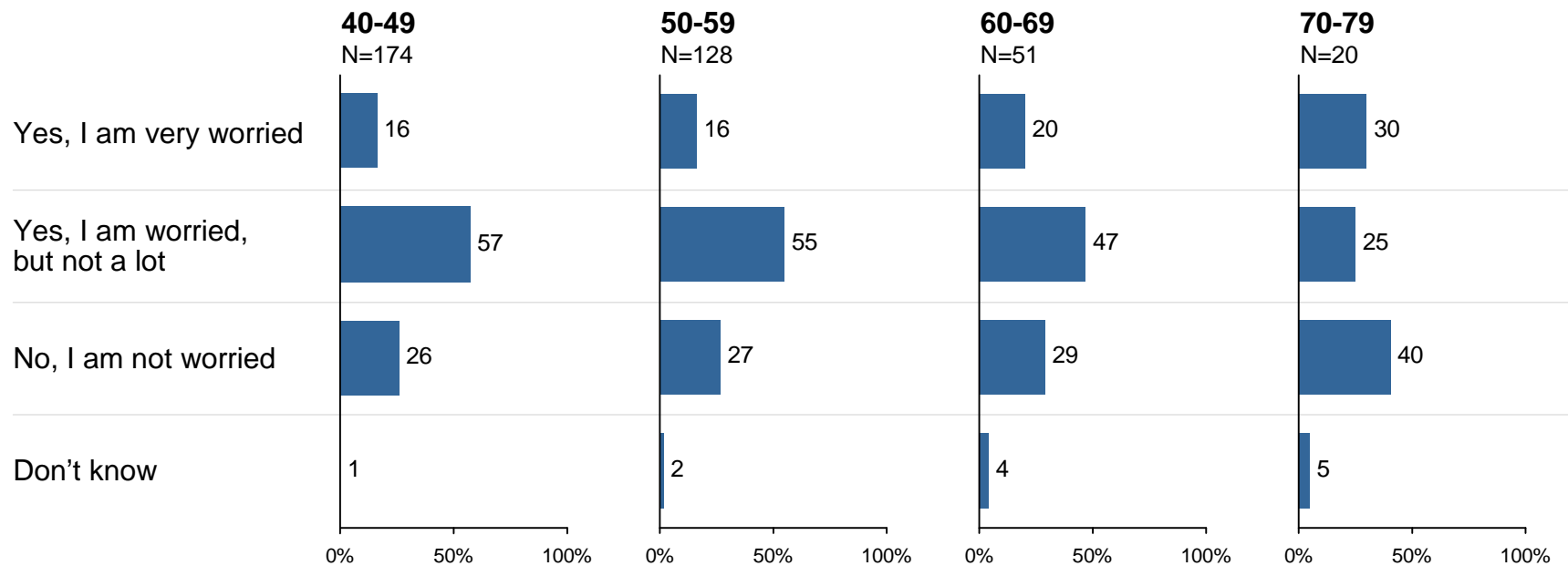

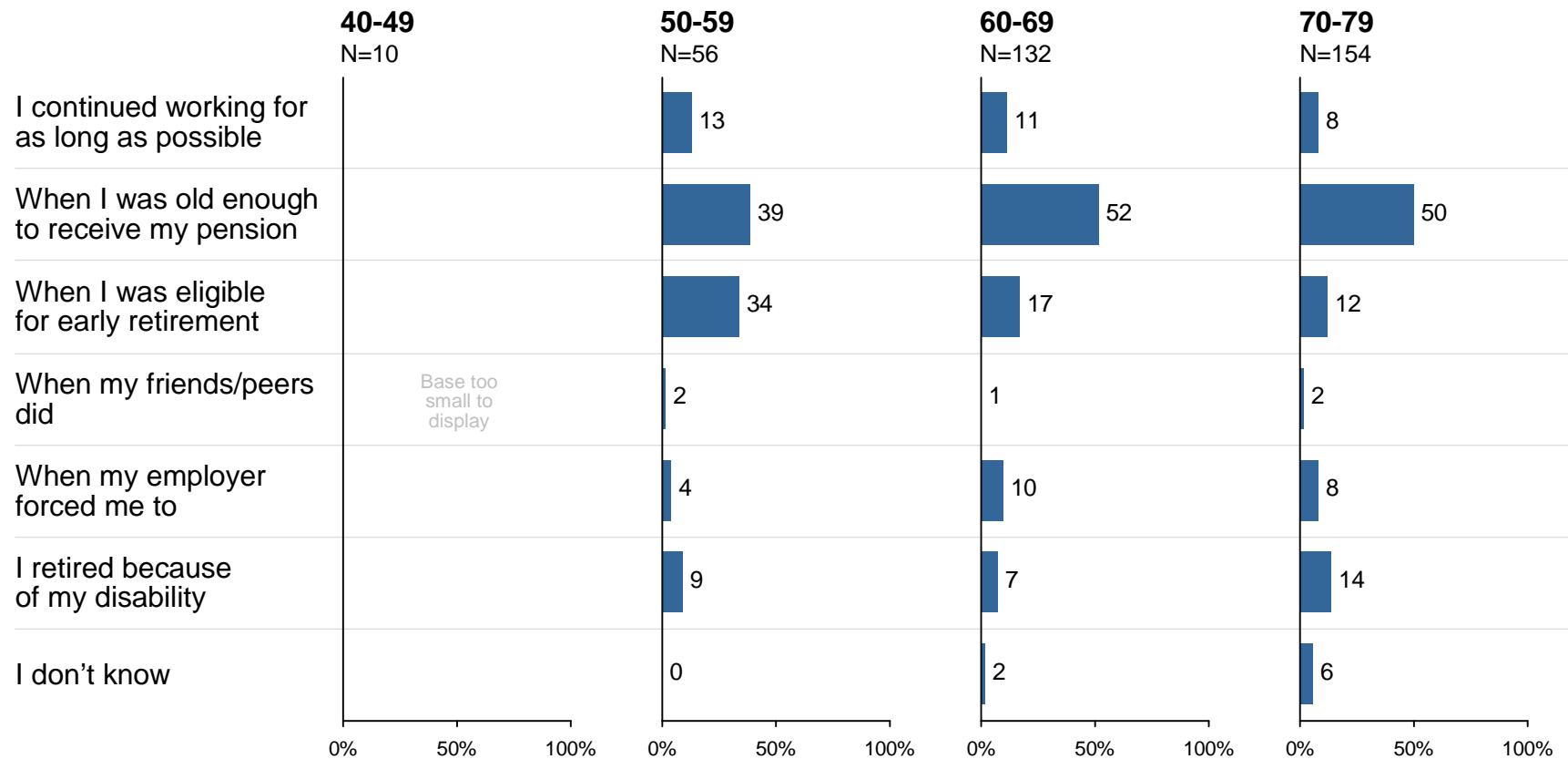

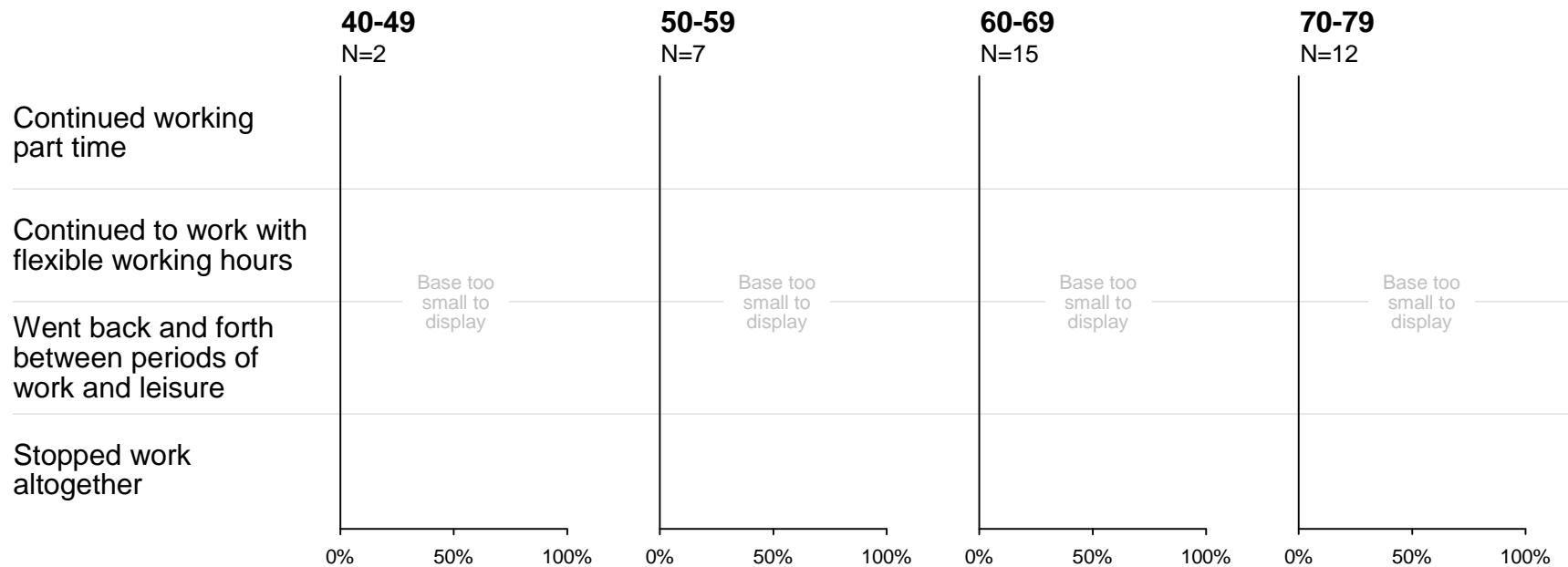

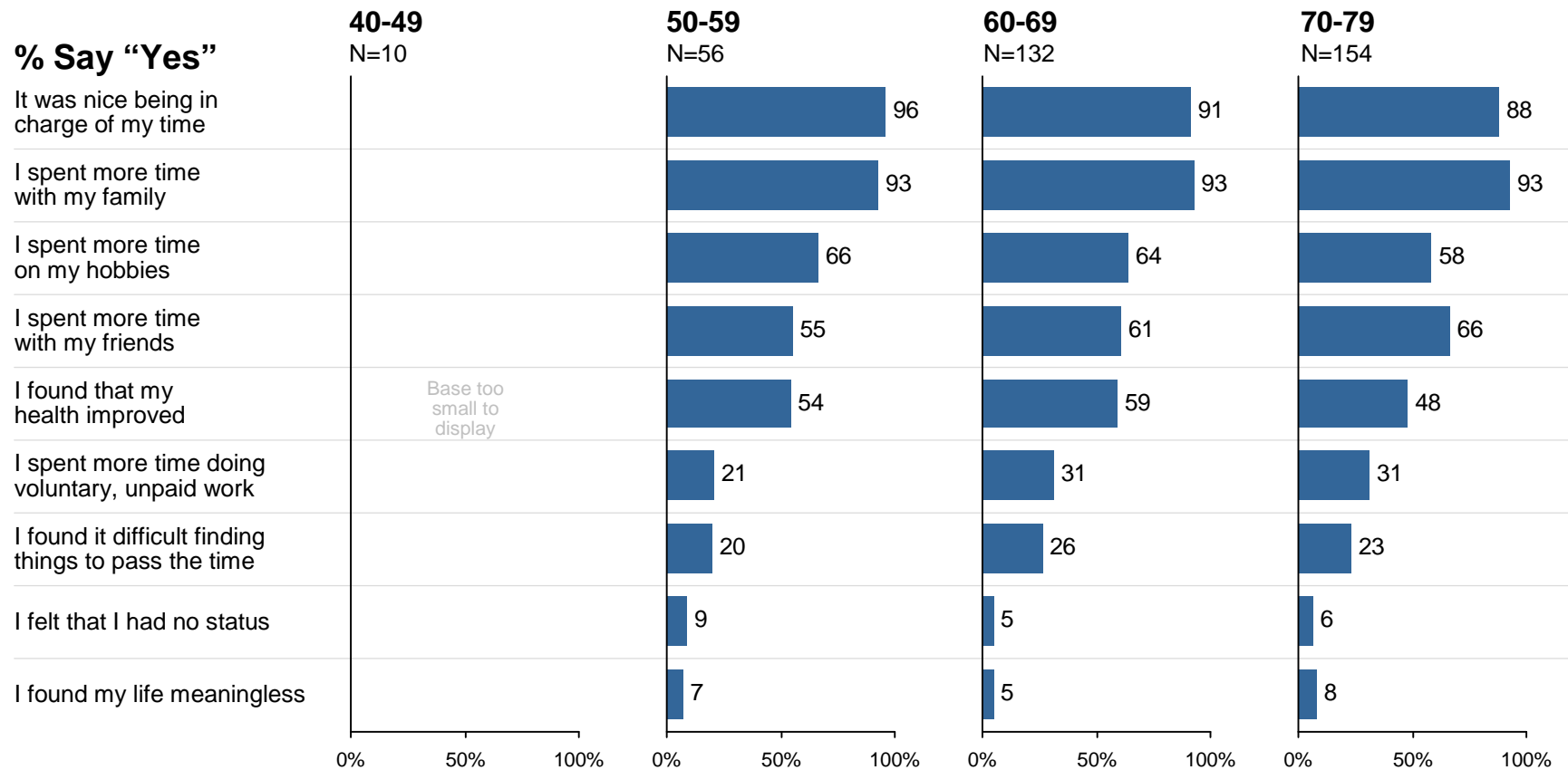

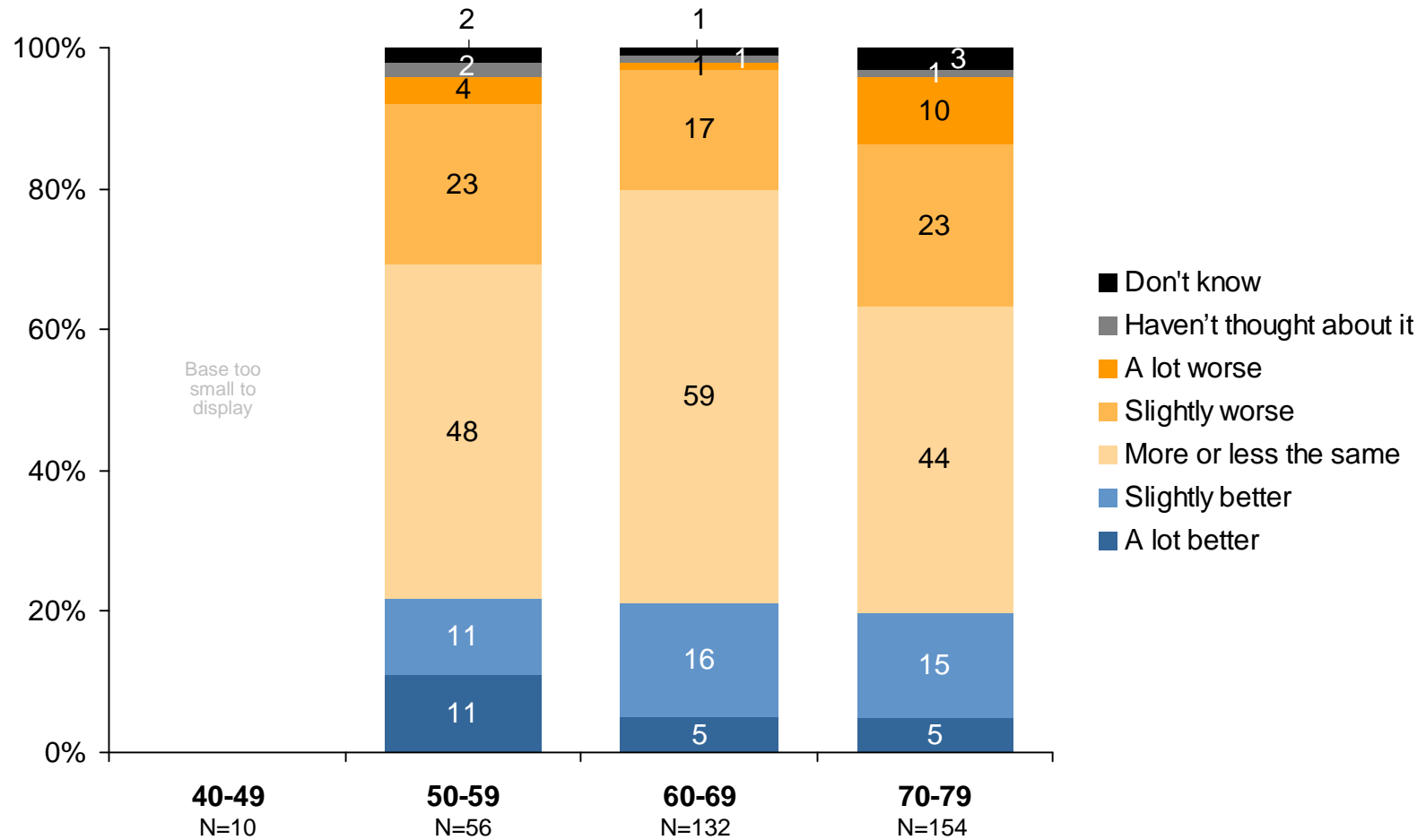

# Is your standard of living better or worse in retirement than it was before?

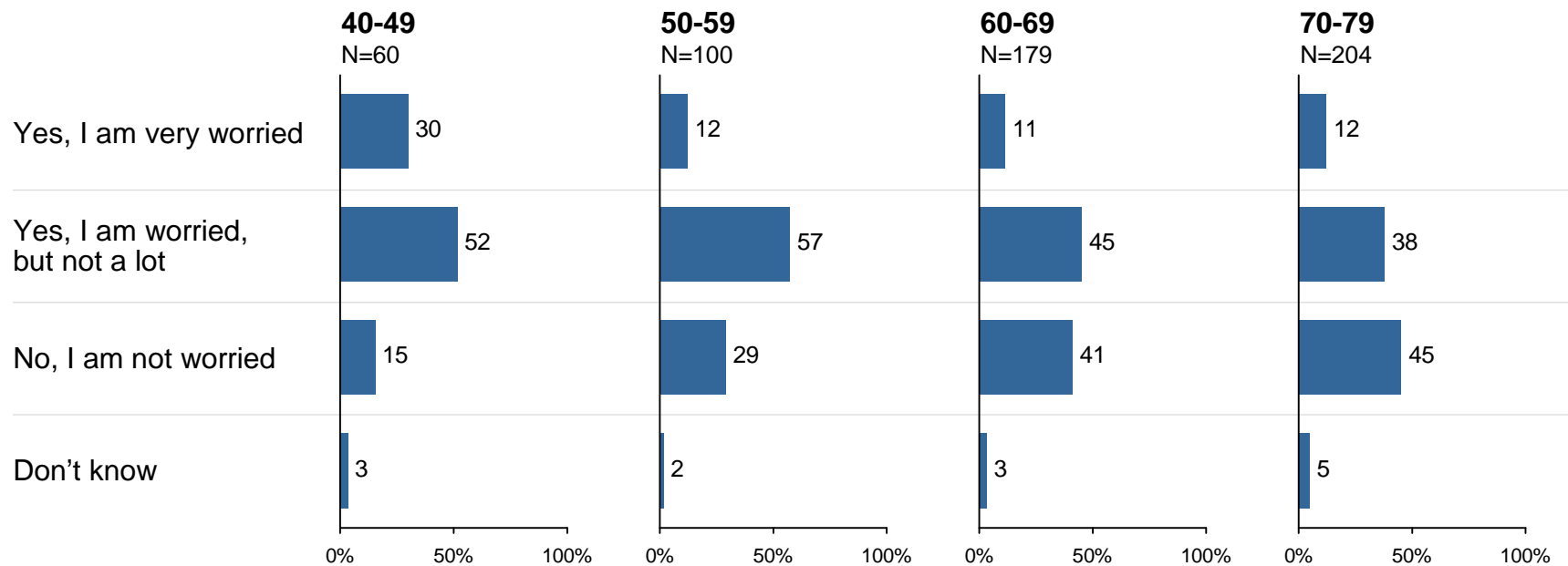

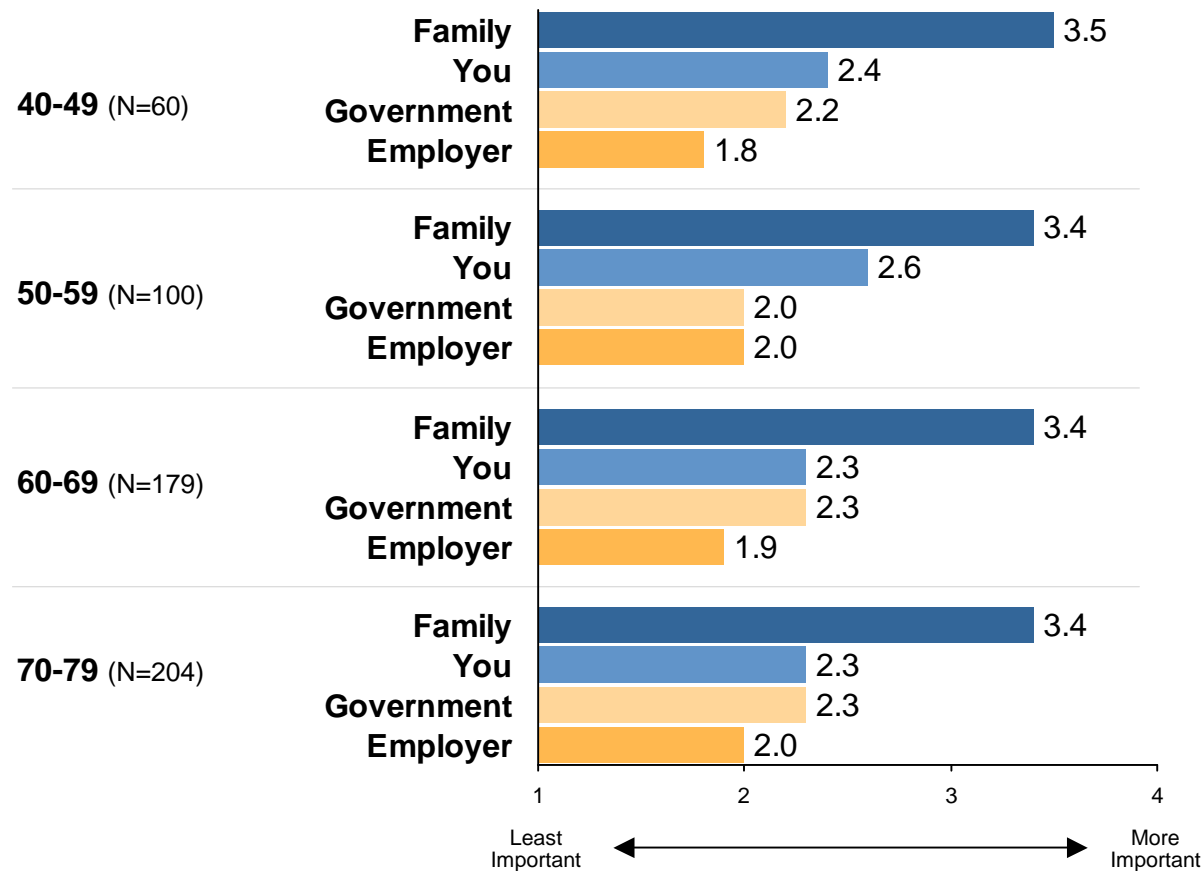

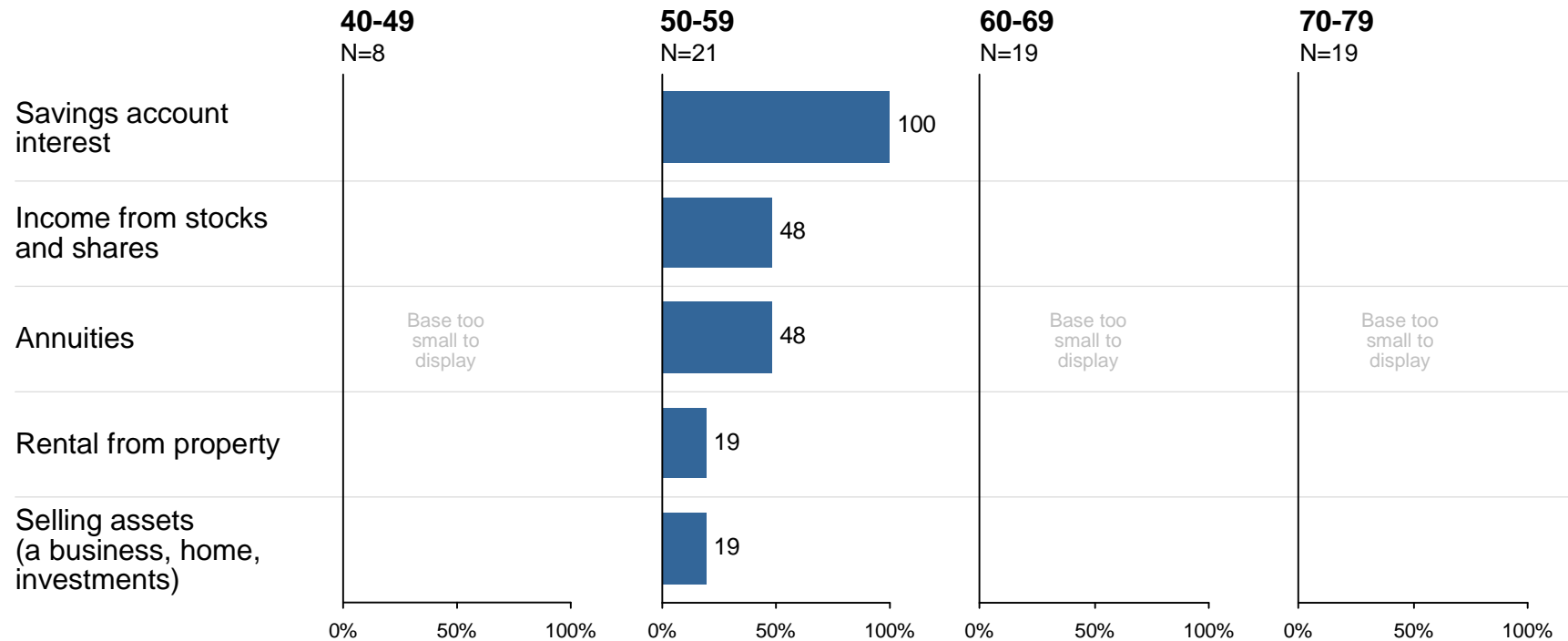
