



## **Changes to Online Banking Daily Limits**

Attention to all HSBC Malaysia customers:

**Effective 11 June 2023**, as part of your account safety and security measures, there are changes made to our Online Banking Daily Limits as below:

- The Third Party Transfer limits are separated into five (5) categories as follows.
  - Overseas Transfer (Telegraphic Transfer)
  - 3rd party HSBC transfer
  - Interbank GIRO (IBG)
  - DuitNow (Online Banking)
  - DuitNow (Mobile Banking)
- "Daily Combined Limit" of MYR 50,000 per day is introduced which is applicable to and shared among all DuitNow (Online Banking, Mobile Banking, QR), Interbank GIRO (IBG) and FPX transfers.
- The maximum limit for Bill Payment and FPX you can set is revised to MYR 50,000.

Table below summarizes the changes made (in **bold**) to Online Banking Daily Limits.
